

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AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF DIZON COPPER-SILVER MINES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

That we, all of whom are of legal age, residents and citizens of the Philippines, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the Philippines.

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: - That the name of said corporation shall be DIZON COPPER-SILVER MINES, INC.

SECOND: - That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

PRIMARY PURPOSE

That the purpose or object for which said corporation is formed is to acquire, purchase, lease, hold, work and operate mines, mining claims, grounds or lodes in the Philippines or other countries; to mine, quarry, work and develop mining grounds, claims or lodes, mining and mineral rights; to crush concentrate, smelt, refine, dress, amalgamate and prepare for market ores, metals and mineral substances of all kinds, and do all other acts and things necessary or conducive to the company's objects, including the erection or buildings or works, and the installing of machinery and appliances or every description whenever required; to mortgage any mining grounds, claims or lodes, mining and mineral rights, or other property belonging to said company and to issue bonds of the company whenever it may be determined to do so.

SECONDARY PURPOSE

To purchase, acquire by lease, license, or otherwise mining grounds, claims or lodes, mining and mineral rights, concession or grants, or any interest therein, and to obtain patents, leasehold rights therefore when desirable;

To construct, carry out, maintain, improve, equip, manage, control or superintend any roads, ways, private railways, private tramways, bridges, reservoirs, water courses, aqueducts, wharves, piers, docks, bulkheads, furnaces, mills crushing, concentrating and smelting works, hydraulic works, factories, dwelling houses and warehouses; to purchase vessels or other means of transportation except railroads other than private railroads, and equip and operate the same as required for the uses and purposes of the company, and also to do any other acts and things relating to mining.

To carry on the business of establishing a Sanitary landfill, to transport and receive the solid waste from Metro Manila, cities, neighboring municipalities and other entities. To invest its funds in the construction, development of the infrastructure, transport facilities necessary or required to attain its objective. To do all acts or things which are calculated directly or indirectly related in order to promote the interest of the corporation or enhance the value of its property.

To act as agent, manager, factor, representative or broker for any person, firm or corporation, domestic or foreign upon commission or otherwise, and to undertake and perform subcontracts, and also to act in any of the business of the corporation through or by any means of agents, brokers, subcontractors or others and for this purpose, to buy, sell, import, export and generally deal in coal, ores and minerals, plants, machinery, drill tools, implements, groceries, provisions, clothing, boots and shoes, furnishing articles, hardware, wooden and metallic ware, with all other articles and things in any way wise required or capable of being used in connection with mining operations and to make and manufacture such articles when required;

To purchase, acquire, hold, convey, sell, rent, mortgage, encumber or otherwise deal in such real and personal property in any part of the Philippines, or elsewhere, as the purposes for which the corporation is formed may permit and as may be convenient or necessary for the transaction of the lawful business of the corporation.

To purchase, acquire, take over, hold, operate, re-organize, liquidate, sell or in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the business and property wherever situated of any person, corporation, syndicate, or partnership, carrying on any business which the corporation is authorized to carry on, or possessed of property suitable for the purposes of this corporation, and to pay for the same property, cash, checks, bonds, debentures or other obligations of the corporation, but only to the extent permitted by law;

Insofar as the same may now or hereafter be permitted by law, to amalgamate, or unite with, to manage, or to combine into this corporation, any other corporation or association or business, whenever formed for objects similar, analogous, or subsidiary to any of the objects of this corporation, carrying on any business capable of being conducted so as to directly or indirectly benefit this corporation, and to acquire, hold, and deal in shares or interest therein to the extent allowed by law;

To sell the undertaking of the corporation or any part thereof for such consideration as the corporation may deem fit, and in particular for shares, debentures, or securities of any other corporation.

To apply for, obtain, register, purchase, lease acquire, hold, use, own, operate, and introduce, sell, assign, or otherwise dispose of, any trademarks, copyrights, trade names,

patents rights, licenses and privileges, inventions, formulas, processes and the like, or any such property or rights.

To borrow or raise money for any of the purposes of the corporation, and in pursuance thereof to make, accept, endorse and issue any instruments and evidences of indebtedness of whatsoever nature and to execute any pledge, mortgage, deed of trust, or issue debentures, bonds, letters of hypothecation, or liens or obligations of the corporation, either at par or premium secured by all or any part of the undertakings, revenues, rights and properties of the corporation, and to exchange or vary from time to time any such security.

Without in any manner limiting the power of the corporation it is hereby expressly declared and provided that the corporation shall have the power to make and perform contracts of any and all kinds and description with any person, firm or corporation, whether public or private, without limit as to amount, and particularly, but not by way of limitation, to make and perform contracts creating rights, casements, and other privileges respecting any of the property, real or personal, of any kind owned by the corporation; to have one or more branch offices outside of the Philippines, and to conduct its business and exercise its powers in any part of the Philippines, in any other country; and in carrying on its business and in order to attain or further its purpose, objects or powers, to do any and all other acts and things and to exercise any and all other powers which a juridical person could do and exercise and which now or hereafter may be permitted by law; and

To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above purpose and objects or any of them, or which may be conveniently carried on and done in connection therewith, or which may be calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any business or property.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers; and it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation.

THIRD – That the place where the principal office of the corporation is to be established or located is at the <u>6th Floor, Sun Plaza Centre, Shaw Boulevard, Barangay Wack Wack, Mandaluyong City, Philippines</u> and branch offices thereof may be established elsewhere. (As amended by a majority vote of the Directors on March 6, 2012 and by at least 2/3 majority vote of shareholders on May 30, 2012.)

FOURTH – That the term for which said program is to exist is fifty 50 years from and after the date of incorporation.



(hereinafter the "Corporation") do hereby certify that at the meeting of the Board of Directors held on March 6, 2012 at Mandaluyong City, these amendments were unanimously approved, and during the special meeting of the shareholders of the Corporation held on May 30, 2012 at the Club Filipino, Greenhills, San Juan, at which meeting, shareholders owning or representing at least two-thirds (2/3) of the outstanding capital stock of the Corporation were present or represented, the following resolutions were, by unanimous vote of the shareholders, approved and adopted the following amendments in Corporation's Articles of Incorporation and By-laws:

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
